The Rev. Canon Dr. Mark A. Pearson is internationally known in the ministry of Christian Healing, having taught and ministered in all but three states and in several foreign countries. The Ministry of Christian Healing

There are two tracks at the same conference so that people at different levels of experience with the healing ministry can attend together.

Introductory - This will help you learn basic things about how you can pray with the sick, either informally with loved ones or as part of a church healing team. We will look at such topics as the use of the gifts of the Spirit in helping others, inner (or emotional) healing and some practical guidance in praying for others. The Bible makes it clear that while there are people specially called and gifted in the healing ministry, any Christian can pray for the sick. While this is true, we want do good, not harm, as we pray for others. The introductory track is designed for people like you.

Advanced - Have you been on a healing ministry team for a while, seen various levels of videos, read various books? We have some helpful teaching to build on that. Lots of time is afforded for your questions. We will look at such things as how to pray with "difficult" people, demonic oppression and possession and how to continue to advance in ministry without its pressures overwhelming or defeating you. This track is put together with veteran prayer people in mind. Topics have been selected in response to requests frequently made by those "in the trenches". We welcome your suggestions for the first afternoon session.

New Creation Healing Center is an interdenominational ministry promoting wholeness in Christ through the practice of Medicine, Massage, Christian Counseling, and Prayer. We are looking forward to the day when we can also offer this through a residential center.
